Farmers Branch City Hall turns 25 today; residents invited by for cake and to sign a card

FARMERS BRANCH ~ Standing as an ageless edifice where generations of local residents have come to participate in their government, Farmers Branch City Hall quietly turns 25 years old today.

In celebration, a small display of photos from the construction process and ribbon cutting on March 31, 1990 is available in the lobby at City Hall today, along with a self-serve birthday cake and a card for local residents to sign.

Built in 1988-89 at a cost of \$6.3 million, City Hall houses the City Manager's Office, City Council Chambers and administrative offices for Finance, Community Services, Public Works, Economic Development, Planning, Fleet and Facilities and Parks and Recreation.

It replaced a much older building that was seriously outdated and undersized for the growing community.
