ORDINANCE NO. 223

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE COST OF
REMODELING THE OLD CITY HALL FOR A POLICE
BUILDING; APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR OUT
OF THE FIRE AND POLICE STATION BOND FUND
UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS
BRANCH, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the Fire
and Police Station Bond Fund Unappropriated Surplus, the sum
of \$44,238.90 for the construction and equipping of a Police
Building.

Section 2. That this project be known as Police Station
Project No. PS-1.

Section 3. Due to the fact that a public necessity exists
for the immediate construction of the aforementioned police
building for the preservation of public peace, health and
safety an emergency is declared and this ordinance is hereby
passed and adopted and made effective from the date of its
passage by adoption on the first reading.
