

ORDINANCE NO. 817

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, SO AS TO CHANGE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM "R-6" SINGLE FAMILY TO "R-6" SINGLE FAMILY CLASSIFICATION WITH A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT TO ALLOW THE PROPERTY TO BE USED FOR A PRIVATE SCHOOL FOR THE EDUCATION OF RETARDED CHILDREN, SAID TRACT BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEING A 7.48 ACRE TRACT, DESCRIBED IN THE TAX RECORDS OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS AS TRACT ONE OF THE JOHN NIX SURVEY, ABSTRACT 1088, AND BEING BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY FYKE ROAD, ON THE EAST BY THE NORTHWEST ADDITION, (A TWO ACRE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH) ON THE SOUTH BY DUTCH VILLAGE NO. 2, (AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH) AND ON THE WEST BY COCHISE LANE. RESTRICTING SUCH PROPERTY TO THE USES PROVIDED FOR UNDER THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, and the governing body of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, in compliance with the Charter of the City of Farmers Branch and the State laws with reference to the granting of changes in zoning ordinance regulations and zoning map, have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise and after holding due hearings and affording a full and fair hearing to all of the property owners generally, and to the persons interested and situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof, the governing body of the City of Farmers Branch is of the opinion that the change of zoning classification should be granted, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas be and the same is hereby amended by amending the Zoning Map of the City of Farmers Branch so as to change the following described property from "R-6" Single family to "R-6" Single family classification with a specific use permit to allow the property to be used for a private school for the education of retarded children.

That the property to be covered by the change of zoning regulations is described as follows, to-wit:

BEING a 7.48 acre tract, described in the tax records of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas as tract one of the John Nix Survey, Abstract 1088, being bounded on the North by Fyke Road, on the East by the Northwest Addition, (a two acre addition to the City of Farmers Branch) on the South by Dutch Village No. 2, (an addition to the City of Farmers Branch) and on the West by Cochise Lane.


Section 2. That all ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That the above described tract of land shall be used only in the manner and for the purposes provided for by the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Farmers Branch as heretofore amended and as amended herein by the granting of this change of zoning classification.


Section 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Farmers Branch, and upon conviction shall be punished by fine not to exceed TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS for each offense.

Section 5. WHEREAS, it appears that the above described property requires that it be given the above zoning classification in order to permit its proper development and in order to protect the public interest, comfort and general welfare of the City of Farmers Branch and creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law in such cases provides.
